COUNCIL FACILITIES CLOSED THIS FRIDAY FROM NOON

Coonamble Shire Council administration office and other facilities—including the pools—will be closed this Friday from noon.

Please plan any business with council or use of facilities around this closure. Facilities and services will operate to normal hours until Friday noon.

Please also note the holiday period closure, from Christmas Day to Sunday, 3 January (inclusive).

Use of fixed hoses now restricted

Water restrictions are now in place for Coonamble residents and businesses.

The restrictions apply to the use of fixed hoses and sprinklers, which should be used between 7pm and 7am only.

Council officers will monitor water usage. Restrictions remain in place until further notice.

Under current laws, the maximum penalty that may be applied for a breach of water restrictions is \$2,200 for corporations and \$220 for individuals.

Watering lawns and gardens during the cooler hours of the morning and evening prevents scalding of leaves and browning off when water heats up too close to the roots of plants.
