

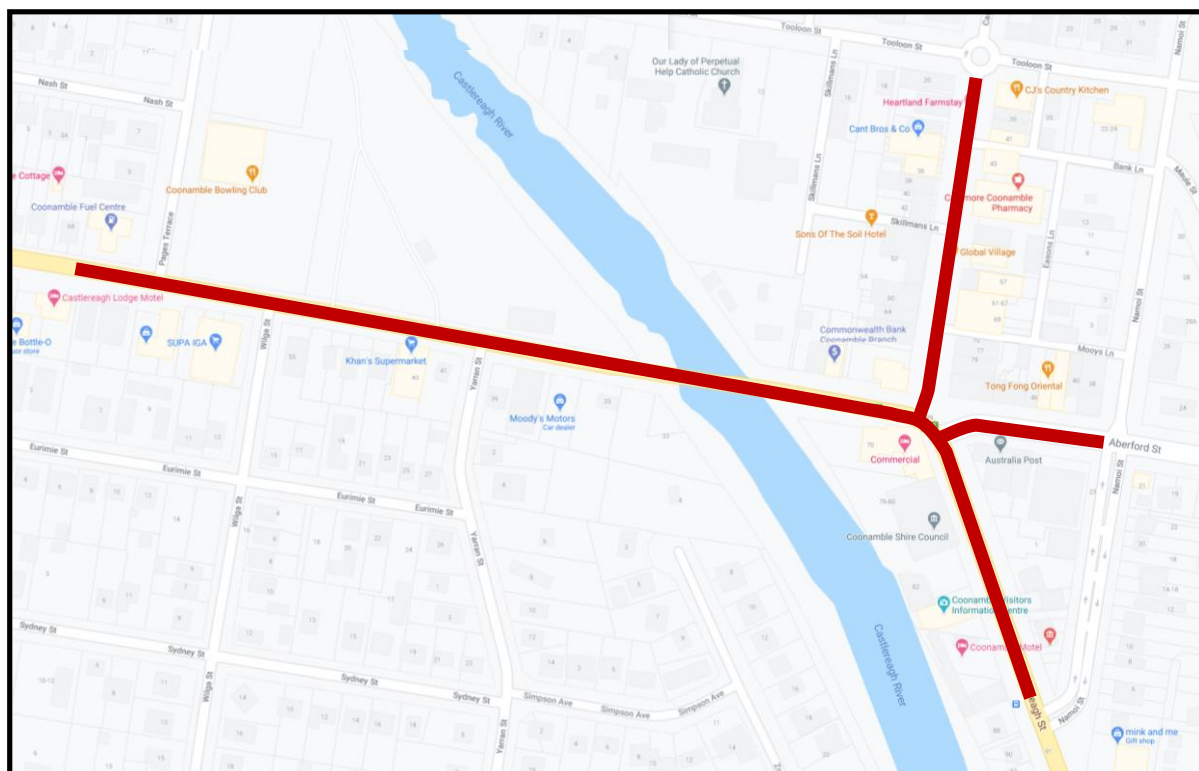
SERVICE NSW – STAFFING CHANGES
