


PROPOSED 40km ZONE

Coonamble Shire Council is proposing to establish a 40km zone covering a section of Aberford and Castlereagh Streets as marked on the map below. Council anticipates that the introduction of this 40km zone will provide for an easier and safer access of vehicles into the main street and a safer environment for pedestrians, drivers and visitors to our town, also considering congestion at the swimming pool and the two (2) supermarkets.

Comments and submissions, in writing, are invited from the public until close of business on Wednesday 21st October 2020.



OCTOBER COUNCIL MEETING - QUAMBONE

Council's next meeting will be held on **WEDNESDAY 14 OCTOBER 2020** at the Memorial Hall in Quambone, commencing at 10.00 a.m.

Should a resident wish to speak at the Community Consultation Session at the Ordinary Meeting for the purpose of putting forward an oral submission, an application must be made to Council before 4.30 p.m. the day before the meeting (Tuesday 13 October). The application must identify the subject matter or item of business on the agenda of the meeting on which the person wishes to speak and whether the person wishes to speak "FOR" or "AGAINST" that item.

OVERGROWN BLOCKS

Council staff has been instructed to report overgrown and unsightly blocks within the urban areas of the Shire. Over recent weeks there have been numerous notices served on owners requesting them to clean up and maintain their yards. Please ensure that blocks are kept clean and tidy – when overgrown the area becomes a fire hazard and a harbourage for pests. When owners do not comply with requirements of the notice, Council may take action to rectify the problem and the cost charged against the property rates, or it may issue a Penalty Notice.

GET YOUR POOL READY FOR SUMMER

Council is asking all residents with private swimming pools to ensure they are registered on the NSW State Government's online register (www.swimmingpoolregister.nsw.gov.au). **Failing to do so could incur a \$220 fine.** Any pool that is capable of being filled with water to a depth of 30cm or more requires a pool fence (child-resistant barrier). If the capacity of the pool or

spa exceeds 2,000 litres it requires Council approval before installation, filling or use.

All pools must be inspected to ensure they are compliant and pool owners are required to provide a valid swimming pool compliance certificate before selling or leasing a property with a pool.
